This correspondence comes with multiple touchpoints and important news for the PWCC Association. Please be sure to read all Bulleted items so that you are informed.

Notice of Special Meeting – Community Landscape Contract

1) **SOCIAL COMMITTEE VACANCIES:** Looking to volunteer for your community? Enjoy working with others & have a creative mind? PWCC is looking for homeowners like YOU to help plan new social activities. Email management if you are interested in helping or joining the PWCC Social Committee.

2) **PET RULES:** Your association is proud to be pet-friendly, and we're happy your four-legged family members are part of the community. While we welcome pets in our association, we have a few rules and requirements.

Pet Violations - Per PWCC Declaration: ARTICLE 8, Section 8.2 (q) Animals... The person walking the pet shall clean-up pet droppings. Further, the Design and Maintenance Guidelines state: Page 16 ... Dogs must be on a leash at all times when off the owner's property. Dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pet on common areas and on their own lot.

Uncollected dog waste can be a serious problem for any association. Next time you're tempted to leave your dog's droppings on the lawn, **please remember we have 14 Dog Waste Stations located throughout the community.**

Due to Numerous Reports of pet owners leaving waste on neighboring properties: It is unlawful for the owner/custodian of an animal to allow any animal to trespass on the property of another, after being asked by the owner/tenant of the property not to allow the animal to trespass. *Please refer to PWC Code Sec. 4-4. (Attachment: Notice of Trespass may be completed and submitted to the County)*

3) **LOST AND FOUND:** Any items found or returned are held in the Clubhouse office. Please be sure to reach out if you have lost an

access card, or personal belonging.

- 4) **COMMUNITY PARKING**: Vehicles parked in parallel spaces throughout the community MUST have current registration & inspection stickers.

Commercial Vehicles are NOT permitted to park overnight within the Community. *This includes; Driveways, Private Alleys and Association streets.* This includes vehicles with any commercial writing or adverts & work vehicles that are not used for passenger daily driving such as Box Trucks.

Single Family Streets are VDOT Maintained. To report commercial vehicles or box trucks call Prince William County Non-Emergency Police 703-792-6500. PWPD will tag the vehicle and notify the registered owner providing 10-days to relocate.

Townhome/Condo Streets – Notify Management with vehicle details. Once verified commercial vehicles are tagged providing 48 hours to relocate or subject to towing.

- 5) **ARCHITECTURAL APPLICATIONS**: If you are planning to conduct an exterior home/beautification project; please contact Management to discuss whether an application is required. This will save time and money to ensure your project meets Association & County Standards.

- 6) **Curbside Yard Waste Collection**: Please be reminded of the Prince William County Yard Waste Collection Guidelines; *ALL* yard waste *MUST* be in approved paper bags found at any local home improvement store. You may also delegate a separate trash bin for yard waste for pickup.

Yard Waste Pickup: Scheduled to resume FRIDAY - MARCH 4, 2022

**Please be reminded, yard waste placed out in plastic bags will NOT be picked up and may warrant a violation citation for your home.

7) **BASKETBALL HOOPS:** ALL temporary basketball hoops should currently be stored out of sight.

With an approved application on file; Basketball Hoops may be placed out on your property beginning - March 13, 2022.

Basketball Hoops – Basketball hoops require approval.

- From the end of Daylight Savings Time to the beginning of Daylight Savings Time, Portable Basketball Hoops must be stored out of sight.
- Hours of play shall be in accordance with the Prince William County Code of Ordinances relating to noise. 10PM
- No Portable Basketball Hoops are allowed in the street per the Prince William County Code of Ordinances.
- **Permanent Basketball Hoops are permitted only in the back/rear of fenced-in Single-Family Homes and shall not be permanently affixed to the homes.**
- For Permanent Basketball Hoops, an Application for Exterior Modification must be submitted to the Covenants Committee.
- As Management has no authority to enforce Prince William County ordinances, residents should call the non-emergency number for the Prince William County police to report complaints.

8) **LEASING YOUR PROPERTY:** Please follow these important steps...

- a. Notify Management, provide copy of lease agreement & emergency contact information.
- b. Return any previously assigned access cards; lost cards carry a fine of \$25/card. No new access cards may be assigned until all prior are closed out.
- c. Provide new tenants "Rental Rules and Regulations" to ensure Community Standards are upheld for your home. Management will provide a copy with receipt of any new lease agreement.
